**Re: Animal workshop**

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited to share with you that we have an animal encounters visit planned for the whole school on Monday the 26th of February.

As Sunflower Class were learning about animals last term and Bluebell Class will be learning about them this term, it is the perfect opportunity for both classes to have up close experiences with a range of animals!

The visit will take place from 1pm and each class will each get to take part in a workshop where they will meet a range of animals. The animals coming in will depend on the health and happiness of each animal on the day, but could include the following: meerkats, skunks, polecats, ferrets, rabbits, guinea pigs, mice, rats, hedgehogs, skinny pigs, tortoises, frogs, snakes, lizards, giant stick insects, giant snails, giant millipedes, scorpions and opossums.

Each animal encounter is a 1-hour hands-on presentation where the presenter will bring a selection of animals, ranging from mammals and reptiles to amphibians and invertebrates. The presenter will bring them out one by one and provide information about the animal before taking them around to be held or touched, depending on the animal.
