



Dear Parents/Carers,

As our topic this half term is At the Bottom of the Garden, we have organised a school trip to Barleylands Farm in Billericay on **Friday 25th May 2018.**

On this day, the Reception children will be picked up from the bus stop at 8.55am on a smaller school bus, and taken straight to the farm.

Whilst at the farm, they will take part in a Little Red Hen workshop and be given opportunities to develop their speaking and listening skills as well as their understanding of the world.

We will leave Barleylands at 2pm and return to school for the remainder of the afternoon. The children will then be dropped back at Union Road at the usual time of 3.45pm.

The school will be subsidising the trip but we are asking for a contribution of £6.00 per child which will go some way towards covering the cost of transport and the entry to the farm. Please give this money to a member of staff in a <u>named envelope</u> by **Friday 11**th **May.**

All children will be required to wear school uniform and bring a healthy packed lunch. If you would like your child to receive a free school packed lunch, please complete and return the form attached. As we will be outside for the majority of the day, please check the weather forecast and ensure that your child is wearing appropriate shoes and outerwear.

We have the capacity to bring three parent volunteers with us on the trip at no extra cost. If you would like to accompany us, please tell a member of staff. Should we have more than three volunteers, we will draw the names from a hat and inform you as to whether you have been selected by 11th May.
