School Uniform Reminders

It's that time of year again when parents/carers purchase new uniform for their children. Attached/On reverse you will find a list of our uniform expectations e.g. colours and range
When making your new purchases please follow our clear school rules;

- For the winter uniform **all** children should be in **plain** [no additional ornamentation please] black school shoes. These should be sensible school shoes that support your child's feet. Children are **not** allowed to wear; boots, trainers, jelly shoes or other sporting type shoes e.g. converse.
- Girls' hair accessories should be of an appropriate size and colour. If the accessories are deemed inappropriate, we will ask the girls to remove them.
- Jewellery – small watch and plain studded earrings only. Children must not have earrings for PE so if you are looking to have your child's ear [s] pierced, this should be done over the summer holidays.
- School dresses, skirts and trousers **must be black**, not grey.
- Children can wear the Summer uniform until October half term. Children must wear winter uniform until the Easter holidays.
- Cardigans and jumpers must be for "school" – no lace inserts or other fashion accessories please
- Key stage 1 children **must use** the school book bags as space in classrooms is at a premium.
- Finally, **label everything please** – our lost property box fills very quickly and if clothing is labelled it is considerably easier for you to find.

Generally, our children look very smart for school. We do not expect you to purchase everything from the school uniform shop as the uniform that requires a logo is also available from Tesco Embroidery Service online and much of the general uniform is available on the high street. However, it is our desire to ensure consistency and a fair approach for all, to uniform wearing. We will send letters home in the new academic year if children are not appropriately dressed for school.

Please also **make sure your child wears** the **school PE kit**.

The children **must wear** the school t-shirt and black shorts. Children can also have a black tracksuit, for wearing in the colder months if desired but this **must** be plain and not have any logos or markings.
