Infection Control and Attendance

With the winter months approaching fast and the weather getting colder, there will be the inevitable onset of bugs and illnesses to contend with. In light of this we wanted to remind you all of the importance of good school attendance and the impact this has on your child's learning. If your child is ill and they need to stay at home, please only keep them off for as long as absolutely necessary. Please make sure you inform the school of any illness your child has or any symptoms you have seen and follow the supplied guidance as to whether they should attend school.

Please do not be offended if you get a call from your child's teacher asking after them. We have asked teachers to become involved in ensuring that all of our students are in school as much as possible. Similarly, we do not support children being taken on holiday in term time. Even though we appreciate that this can make holidays considerably cheaper, it can also have a detrimental effect on a child's learning. If your child is going to be absent from school for any reason other than illness, please complete the 'absence from learning' form available from our website in the 'forms for parents' menu and submit to the school office as soon as possible.
