Dear Parents/Carers,

At Concordia Academy, we place a great deal of emphasis on reading. A love of reading will lead to a love of learning and so it is important that we encourage our children to have a passion for books both in school and at home.

In order to do this, we send home a variety of books for you to read with your child. Alongside the reading books, your child has a Reading Record, which you should write in whenever you read with your child.

The expectation is that you write the date, title of the book and a comment. For example:

Some other ideas of comments that you might include are:


- Read familiar words independently.
- Able to predict what happens next in the text.
- Worked out new words by sounding them out.
- Discussed the story and characters.
- Self-corrected own errors independently.
- Used the picture cues and the first sound of a word to work out words.
- Read with fluency and expression
- Struggled to concentrate.
- Able to read this book with lots of help.
- Created tension as he did not want to read.
- Did not understand what he has read.
