Homework	<p><i>A Homework Letter will be sent out every Friday detailing weekly homework.</i></p> <p>Reading - Reading books sent home every Friday - additional reading books sent out upon request or at teacher's discretion.</p> <p>Maths - An update should be sent to parents in the weekly homework letter about what children have been learning, and what they are learning the following week. Worksheets or game activities will be sent home weekly as additional practice, these should be consolidation of what the children have been learning in school (and not new learning). MyMaths to be launched in the Summer term for Y1 children.</p> <p>Writing/Comprehension - This should be sent home at least every couple of weeks. Writing activities should be accompanied by reminders of key writing strategies children should be using, such as Fred Fingers, finger spacing, capital letters and full stops.</p> <p>Spelling - spelling homework should be sent home every Friday for children to practise their weekly spellings. Strategies for spelling should be outlined in the homework letter - use of Fred Fingers for green words and LCWC for red words.</p> <p>Project work - This should be sent home every half term. Project work should be related to the current topic, and should include (where possible) opportunities to develop a wide range of skills, including research.</p>
