We would like to inform you about our curriculum plan for the first half term. Year 2 will be learning about **'Street Detectives'** as their topic focus this term.

English	The children will be following either the RWI or Literacy and Language programme. Your child will be working in a group specific to their
	reading and writing needs so that they are challenged and taught appropriately and able to make excellent progress. Children will also be
	learning a different grammar and punctuation focus each week.
PSHCE/SEAL	The topic will be Belonging to a Community . The children will be

Subject	Content
Reading	All children in Year 2 are currently reading using the Read, Write, Inc.
	programme. You can support your child at home further by reading at
	home with them for at least 20 minutes every day . The reading books





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	will be changed on a weekly basis. When you read with your child please write a comment in their reading record book.
	Do encourage children to 'Fred talk' (sound out) words as they read. You can also encourage your child to sound out unfamiliar words in non-reading books and signs on display around us. Reading book changes Friday
Maths	Please support your child to learn their 2, 5 and 10 times tables, and associated division facts. Using Maths in everyday situations will help your child to learn. Ask them to read the time, how much change they should get when buying small items etc.

For health and safety reasons, it is very important that your child has their PE kit in school. Our main PE lesson will be taught on a **Thursday** but will be supplemented by an additional lesson on another afternoon of the week. As such, PE kits can be kept in school and returned at the end of each half term.
