Star of the week in Sunflower Class is Hawaa! Hawaa's reading has been excellent during Guided Reading time, and she has been working very hard to use


her sounds. She even uses her sounds on very tricky words and also remembers all her red words. She has now moved on to reading red books! Well done, Hawwa!




HEADTEACHER AWARDS
