Throughout the Autumn term Year 2 have been learning about The Great Fire of London. As part of this learning we will be visiting the Tower of London on **Tuesday 19th November 2019.**

On this day, the Y2 children will come to school at 8.30am. At 8.45am sharp we will walk to Romford station and take public transport to the Tower of London. We will return to school by 3pm and home time arrangements will be the same as usual on the day.

Whilst at the Tower of London the children will take part in a 'Fire! Fire!" workshop followed by a tour. The children will meet a costumed character who will describe these terrible events and tell the story of Mr Pepys watching the flames from inside the ancient Tower walls.
