| Reading | All children in year one are currently learning to read using the Read, Write, Inc. programme. You can support your child at home further by reading at home with them for at least 15 minutes every day . The reading books will be changed on a weekly basis. Do encourage children to 'Fred talk' (sound out) words as they read. You can also encourage your child to sound out unfamiliar words in non-reading books and signs on display around us. Reading book changes Friday RWI books will change as children complete each unit. This may be mid-week. |
| Maths | This term we will continue using Effective Maths Quiz as part of our math homework. The children are expected to complete a set quiz each week. Please support your child to learn to securely count to at least 100. Please also help them to write numbers to 100 with the correct orientation. We are consolidating children's learning of place value this term and you can support your child by encouraging them to count objects and question children by asking them more than and less than questions e.g. What is 1 more than 10? |
