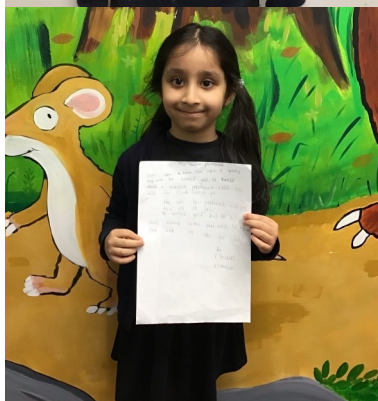

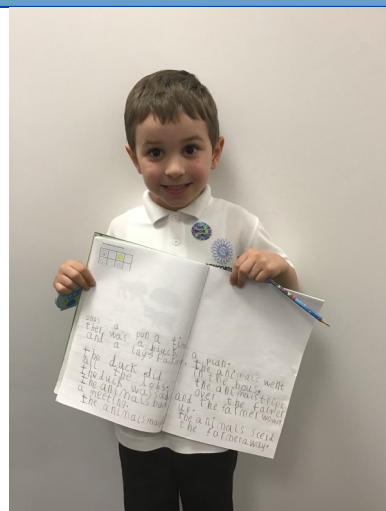
In Poppy Class, Vilte received a Headteacher Award this week for working really hard during Maths. She showed great focus during our coin sorting activities this week.

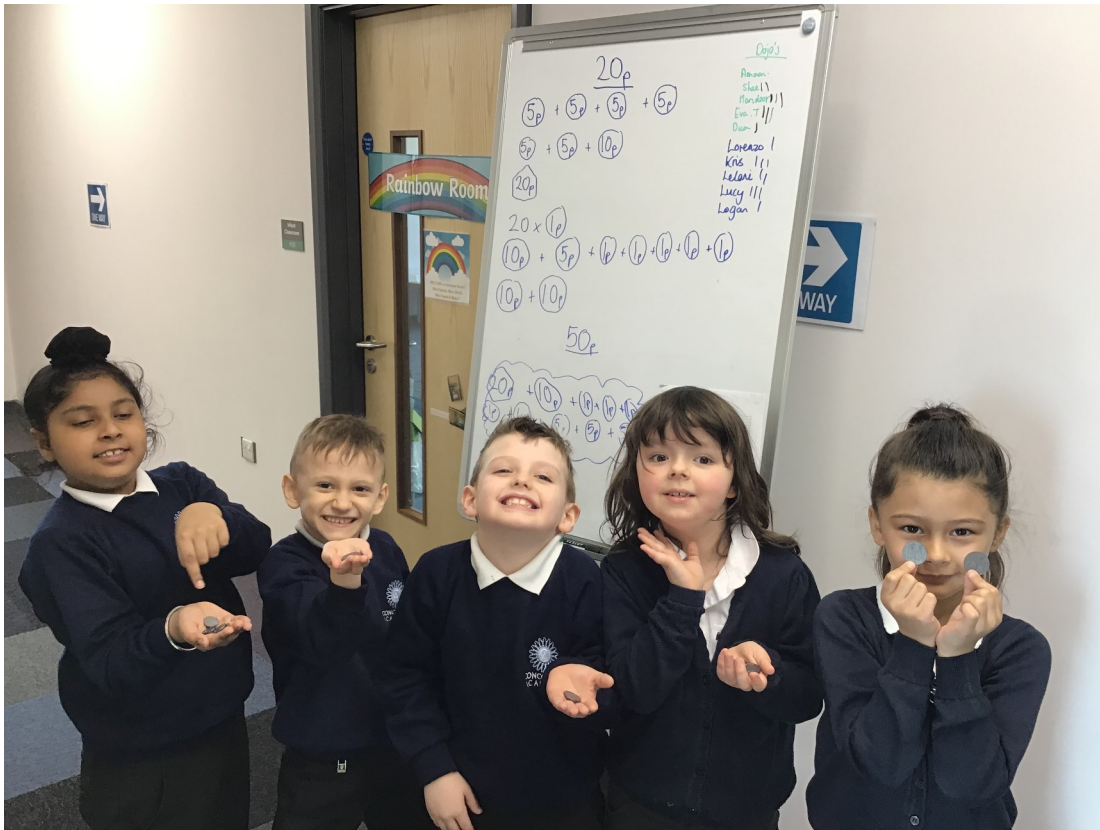
