Maths	Topics we will be covering include counting, place value and addition
	and subtraction which will be taught using the White Rose scheme.
	Year 1 will also be taught number fluency through a Mastering Number
	scheme to ensure they have a deep understanding of number.
English	The children will be following the Ruth Miskin Read Write Inc Scheme
	for Phonics. Your child will be working in a group specific to their
	reading and writing needs so that they are appropriately challenged
	and taught, and able to make excellent progress.
PSHCE/SEAL	The topic will be My Family and Me. The children will learn:
	- To know what makes me and others special.
	- Compare similarities and differences between me and others.
	- To understand and respect that there are different types of
	families.
	- To explain how different people care for me.
	- To name different parts of my body.
	- To differentiate between male and female using the correct
	vocabulary.

History and	The children will be learning about Black History. We will be
Geography	exploring Notting Hill Carnival including how the carnival began and
	the different types of music and costume used to celebrate Caribbean
	culture. The children will create their own carnival headdress that they
	will use to take part in a school carnival.
Science	The focus in Science this half term will be Animals: Including
	Humans. The children will learn about different kinds of animals and
	their classifications. They will also learn about humans focusing on
	body parts and senses.
PE	Consolidating core physical development skills. Children will be learning
	Gymnastics this term.

RE	We will be learning about Hinduism . They will be focusing on Diwali: The festival of light and why it is important within the Hindu faith.
Music	The focus for Music this term will be Pulse & Rhythm . Children will be creating music with a variety of tuned and untuned instruments.
Art & DT	The focus for Art this term will be Drawing. Children will be exploring mark making through different drawing materials. They will begin to draw from observation using faces and self-portraits as a stimulus.

Homework:

Subject	Content
Reading	You can support your child at home further by reading at home with them for at least 30 minutes every day . Their reading books will be changed on a weekly basis. When you read with your child, please write a comment in their reading record book.
	Do encourage children to 'Fred talk' (sound out) words as they read. You can also encourage your child to sound out unfamiliar words in non-reading books and signs on display around us.
	By the end of the year, Year 1 children should be reading around 60 words per minute so please encourage your child to read with speed and expression.
	Reading book changes Friday
Maths	Please support your child to learn to correctly count and write numbers to 30. We are consolidating children's understanding of place value and calculation this term. You can support by asking questions such as, 'What is 1 more/less than 20?' and 'If I have 10 bananas and buy 4 more, how many will I have?' or 'If I have 23 cupcakes and I eat 6, how many are left?'

Children are required to wear their PE kits to school on the relevant days.
