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## CURRICULUM CORNER—Y3

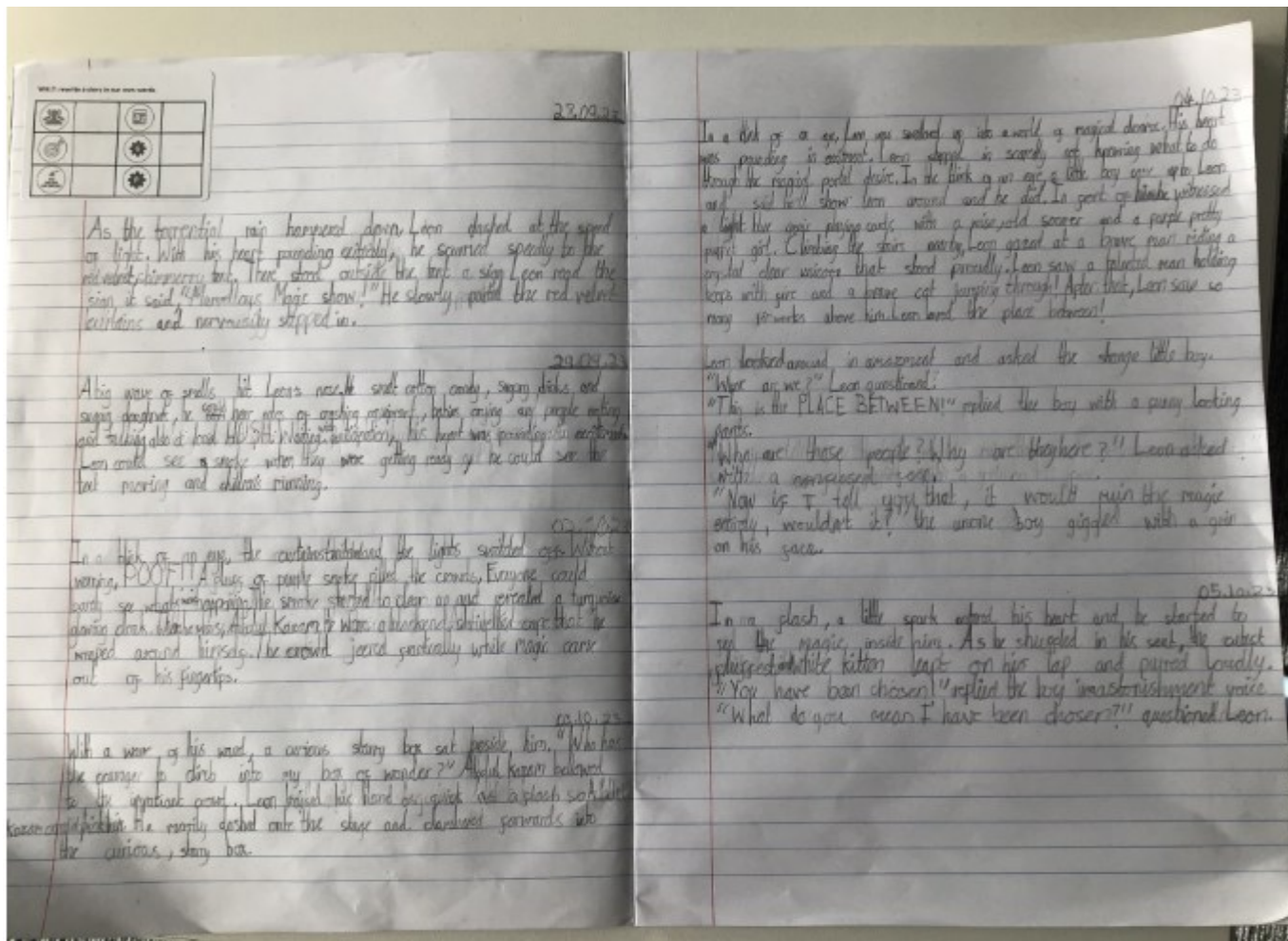
This week, Year 3 have been learning about Cassa Pancho and Ballet Black as part of our Black History Month module.
