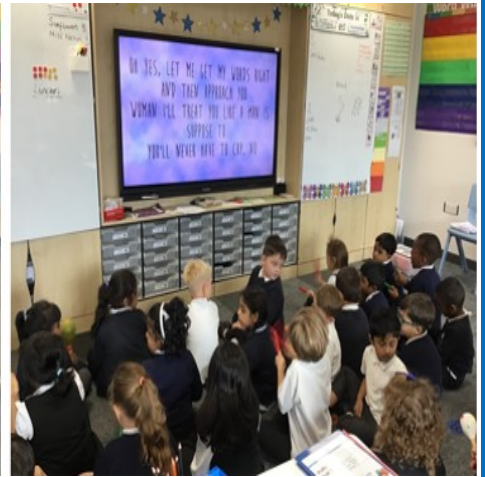

Dedicated Absence Line and Email

Parents should call our absence line on 01708 932710 and choose option 1 to report an absence. This will take you to a voicemail where you can record your message. Alternatively, you can report this on your Arbor app or by emailing attendance@concordiaacademy.co.uk

If you do not report your child absent it will be recorded as unauthorised.



Reasons for a students absence

There are only two authorised reasons for absence:

- Your child is too unwell to attend school
- You have sought advance permission from the school for your child to be absent



Medical appointments

- Non-urgent/routine appointments should be scheduled outside of school hours
- Inform the school in advance and provide proof of urgent appointments for an authorised absence—pupils should be absent for the minimum amount of time possible.



Holidays - NOT permitted

We do not authorise holidays or absences taken during term time.
